Over time he got better and started including tricks into his routines and has never looked back since.

On the practical side Jamie treated the boys to a demonstration of his vast range of different skills whilst the group looked on in astonishment. He then went on to coach the boys and encourage them to devise their own new moves.

Each of the boys were presented with a specially designed ball called the Mamba that is made to improve the skills of young players.
