Year 7 results:

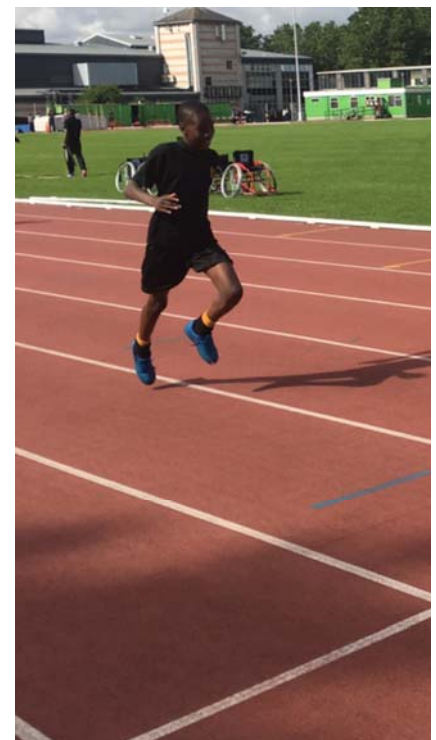
