

Understanding Your Son's Achievement Card

Grades and levels are given by class teachers and used to track progress.

Previous Grade

This is the grade your son was working at last term.

Current Grade

This is the grade your son is currently working at.

Minimum Expected Grade

This is the grade your son should expect to achieve in his GCSE/BTEC exams at the end of Year 11.

Aspirational Target Grade

This is the grade your son should aim to achieve in his GCSE/BTEC exams at the end of Year 11.

For all subjects the grading is based on numbers 9-1, with 9 being the highest and 1 the lowest. Where the number grade is followed by a letter (4H, 4M, 4L), it means H being High, M being Middle and L being Low. A 'W' means working towards grade 1.

BTEC grades are awarded with the highest achievement being D* - Distinction plus, D - Distinction, M - Merit, P - Pass, I – Incomplete and F- Fail, being the lowest grade awarded.

Level 1 Sport is graded 1-4, with 1 being the highest and 4 being the lowest.

Effort, Behaviour and Homework Level

These are assessed as follows:

1 = Outstanding; 2 = Good; 3 = Satisfactory; 4 = Improvement needed.
