

School Uniform

All students are expected to be in full Rokeby School uniform at all times. The uniform requirements are outlined in detail in the table below.

Non uniform coats

All non-uniform coats which are seen by staff will be taken for safe keeping and held until the end of the week.

Side bags

Side bags are not big enough to hold exercise and text books. This means that students who come to school with only a side bag are not ready for learning. For this reason, side bags will be taken for safekeeping and students will be issued with a Rokeby bag until they bring an appropriate bag to school.

Shoes

Students who come to school wearing non uniform shoes such as trainers or plimsolls will be expected to remove them and to change into Rokeby School shoes (loaned for the day by student services). If this happens, you will be notified. This will be a temporary solution and students will be expected to have correct school shoes as soon as possible.

Ties

We will continue with the current policy of lending students a tie for the day if they arrive at school without one. Again this will be a temporary solution and students will be expected to have a tie as soon as possible.
