THE ASDAN TEAM - A BLOOMIN' SUCCESS

We planted daffodils in October and November last year. We put soil in the pots and then three tete-a-tete bulbs in the small pots and 6 bulbs in the big pots and covered them with more soil. Next, we put them in the greenhouse to grow over winter.

On 22nd February we found that all the daffodils had bloomed and there were lots of perfect, beautiful yellow flowers. We took all the trays of daffodils to the staffroom to sell to members of staff. We charged 50p for the small pots and £1 for the big pots and we sold out!
