7	You will be looking at Op Art. Task 1: Create a series of shapes from the work sheet provided. You can print it off or copy from your computer screen. Make sure you read the power point properly and then submit your completed work on to google class. Task 2 will be set next week.
8	Students will look at the work of Jess Albert. You will then complete an artist analysis of about her artwork. Follow the power point then submit the work on google drive.
9	Using your selfies, you will create another A4 portrait using pencil, or pen to create a tonal study. Look at the artist example in the powerpoint to inspire you. Then upload your work to the google class.
10	Mrs Roberts class: This week you will be looking at the work of John Kerr. Create an analysis and a response to his work. Pay attention to the power point provided and then submit your completed work in the google class. Ms Mishra's class: All Lessons: Create a response to the work 'Eye of the Strom' by Michael Craig Martin. You can draw from the pictures you took for the last week's work.
11	Record ideas: You have time on your hands, so look at your surroundings and create an artwork in response to what you see. Find an artist to inspire the style of your drawing / painting / photo editing.
