7	PHOTOSHOOT! Create a photoshoot of a still life using household objects. Consider the setting, look for suitable surface and background. Look at the examples on the worksheet.
8	"BIG BUGS" Students will begin to draw their own large scale bug filling an A4 page. They are encouraged to use paint, or colour pencil and drawing pencil to create a detailed study. They will use prior skills from the close up lessons to create the textures and shapes of their big bug drawing. They can also seek inspiration from Jess Albert.
9	Students to copy one of Roy Lichtensteins portraits using felt tip pens.
10	Mrs Roberts class: Students to complete John Kenn response from last week. Ms Mishra's class: Take a few newspapers and magazine pages and stick them on an A4 paper forming a background. Try to make it as interesting as possible with the news articles that interest you. Pick 3 kitchen, an electronic gadget and 2 tools (Photograph every single item you use as we will use them later). Draw just the outline of these in MCM style. They should be overlapping. After drawing in pencil outline using a black bold pen like MCM's work.
