7	Find three objects in your house you can redraw in the style of Keith Larsen, who we looked at last week. Add human features to your objects such as eyes and mouths. Use existing details to help you with this - see the PowerPoint for an example.
8	Create a still life photoshoot in the style of Ralph Goings. Set up your photograph considering the placement of the objects (composition) and the colours to ensure the image looks 'considered' (thought about). Take THREE photographs from different angles as you will select one to draw next week. Submit all three to google class.
9	Copy a piece of either Todd Marone's or Adam Neate's artwork in your book, try and achieve the same effects. colours and finish that do in their work. Collect toilet roll tubes - about 3 or 4 for next week's work.
10	Mrs Roberts class: Create a zine template. Using the template plan out your comic book story, remember the direction the image must go in ready to start make your final outcomes next week. Ms Mishra's class: Continuing from last week choose 2-3 objects from the drawing and add flat water colour on them as shown in the ppt. Some objects can have a flat background in the shape of a square or rectangle.
