7	Week 2 of two-week task. Using your photograph of your still life, create an A3 drawing in the style of Roy Lichtenstein. You can use your own choice of material (paint, felt tips, colour pencils), but it must be colourful and have bold outlines and dots.
8	Create THREE studies in the style of Ralph Goings. You have been provided a selection in the PowerPoint to choose from, however, you can find your own if you prefer.
9	Create a response to the artist, Julia Kay. Read over the PowerPoint first so you are aware of how to do this.
10	Mrs Roberts class: Create a series of shadow creatures using Vincent Bal's artwork as inspiration. Find toys / household objects that you can cast a shadow on to create interesting shapes which can then be extended into unusual creatures based on your previous investigations. Add colour to your creatures and finer details to create texture. You may wish to, as an extension task, add an imaginative background to develop a story around your shadow creature. Create 3 A4 pieces. Ms Mishra's class: Pick two of the object drawings from the previous task. Draw a grid on an A4 paper and draw parts of the selected objects in each square. Draw parts of the objects from different angles. Once the drawing is finished use water colours to add details in each square. Look at the example in the worksheet given.
